Leslie Marsh Leading Fireman - Central Fire Station

On the 07th February 1949 Leslie Marsh attended a fire at Fox Street Aston where he fell through a hole on the first floor and sustained spinal injuries from which he died several days later



Derek George William Andrews Sub Officer - Ladywood Fire Station

On the 25th August 1972 Derek Andrews was attending a factory fire in Birmingham when a building collapsed on him Dereck died before reaching hospital.



George William Barrett Sub Officer - D Division Fire Prevention

On the 02nd December 1976 whilst on a routine inspection in a fire service van was involved in a Road Traffic accident. George Barrett sustained severe multiple injuries and died before reaching Hospital.



Ian Robert Collier Firefighter - Acocks Green Fire Station

On the 29th May 1977 Ian attended an incident on a railway embankment in Solihull. During firefighting operations Ian was struck by a train and sustained severe injuries from which he died.

Robin John Gleeson Leading Firefighter - Walsall Fire Station

On the 14th August 1982 Robin attended a fire in Walsall. During Firefighting Operations Robin sustained severe head injuries from which he later died.



Dennis Michael Flint Firefighter –Sutton Coldfield Fire Station

On the 22nd September 1983 Dennis attended a fire in Birmingham. During firefighting operations Dennis was struck by a bale of paper and sustained severe multiple injuries from which he died.



James Leslie Jennings Firefighter –Wolverhampton Fire Station

On the 25th March 1985 after returning from a fire Jim was found in the dormitory not breathing following a Cardiac arrest he was pronounced dead at the scene.




Nicholas Mark Walker Firefighter –Bournbrook Fire Station

On 29th June 1985 Nicholas was part of a crew responding to a fire in Birmingham when the appliance was involved in a serious road traffic accident Nicholas received severe head injuries from which he died several days later.

On the 27th July 1992 Iain attended a fire in a Multi Block of Flats in Birmingham. During firefighting operations Iain sustained severe burns and internal injuries from which he died



Andrew Clinton Firefighter –Bournbrook Fire Station

On the 09th March 2003 Andrew Clinton was training on the Hydraulic Platform when he fell from the Platform and sustained a severe head injury from which he later died.



Brian Dean Firefighter –Bloxwich Fire Station
