Chairman's Comments.

As you are probably aware the virus had had a great impact on all organisations including NARF. All NARF meetings at Branch and Borough levels have been cancelled until further notice although a few have been held on zoom. The Erdington Office has been closed and e-mails dealt with remotely. As AGM's were cancelled the various decisions that would have been made have been delayed and the 'Status Que' has prevailed until the time when we can ratify things.

The National Council at their October 2019 meeting agreed to raise the national subscription for NARF to £12 from it's current £9. This will take effect from 1st January 2021. Although this increase appears to be above inflation it will be the first increase in National Subscriptions for approximately 15 years. Over that time the associations costs have risen and are a lot higher than they were then with the publication and postage of the NARF News a good example. Postage went up again on 23rd March 2020. The West Midlands Committee hope members agree this is still good value for the work undertaken at National, District, Branch and Borough levels.
